

In addition to our dog guide program, we offer programs that enhance a person's independence and quality of life in other ways, including orientation and mobility training, Trekker training, and seminars for Orientation and Mobility professionals. Currently, Leader Dogs is the only facility in the Western Hemisphere to teach deaf-blind students to work with a dog guide,

Thanks to generous donations from our supporters, our dog guide services are provided free of charge, including room and board, and travel to and from our campus in Rochester Hills, Michigan, for students living in North America.

Leader Dogs is recognized as a "Best in America" Charity by the Independent Charities of America (ICA).

#### **Eversight Michigan**

Eversight is a charitable, not-for-profit organization dedicated to the preservation and restoration of sight through transplantation, research, education and partnership. Eversight recovers, evaluates and provides human eye tissue for transplantation; supports research into causes and cures of blinding eye conditions; promotes donation awareness through public and professional education; and provides humanitarian aid to people around the world in need of sight restoring services.

#### Bear Lake Camp

We aspire to provide a premiere outdoor recreational/educational facility providing opportunities for people of special needs to enhance self-worth, attain independence, acquire social skills and realize their full potential as human beings. We are dedicated to working with the greater community and include them as a partner in addressing the needs of society. We intend to provide an atmosphere that is wholesome, and encourages awareness and appreciation of our natural environment.

Summer sessions are available for children who are blind and visually impaired, deaf and hard of hearing and those with juvenile arthritis.

#### Lions of Michigan All-State-Band\*

Each year since 1948 high school band students have represented the Lions of Michigan in their annual parade during the Lions Clubs International Convention. Originally a high school band was selected to represent the state. In 1978 it was decided to let students from across Michigan participate and the All State Band was formed and it has performed at the convention ever since. The All State Band has become one of the Michigan Lions' most acclaimed youth activities.

All State Band provides its members with experience in four major areas: musical performance, travel & education, sociological growth, and "We Serve"—the Lions motto. Band members are Leo members who perform concerts at hospitals, orphanages, and retirement centers. They are Lions goodwill ambassadors.

#### **PAWS With A Cause**

Paws With A Cause enhances the independence and quality of life for people with disabilities nationally through custom-trained assistance dogs. PAWS increases awareness of the rights and roles of assistance dog teams through education and advocacy.

We have placed more than 2,700 assistance dogs throughout the country in our 38-year history, and currently provide services in 29 states. More than 300 families are PAWS dog volunteers.

In honor of their 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary, Lions Clubs International Foundation will be starting a 3-year \$500 million campaign. Our district will respond with at least a 10% increase in donations during the first year.

#### District Governor's Official Visit\*

The District Governor or a Vice Governor is required to make an official visit to each club during the year. With 43 clubs to visit, not counting special events, meetings and Conventions, the Governor's and Vice-Governors' schedules are quite busy. The following suggestions will help your club make the Governor's visit a pleasurable and productive one.

- Plan early for Governor's visit. Contact the Governor to confirm as early in the year as possible.
- Choose a date that is likely to have high attendance.
- Your request for a visit should include all pertinent information such as date, time, location, and if a meal will be served.
- No other speakers or programs, other than abbreviated business meetings, should be scheduled for this evening.
- Assign a member to greet the Governor. If the club has particular concerns or issues it would like the Governor to address, inform the Governor before the meeting.
- Prepare a suitable introduction for the governor. A past Lion dignitary might introduce the Governor.
- All members should rise when the Governor is officially introduced and when the remarks have concluded. Let the Governor know in advance if you want him to induct new members, club officers or present special awards.
- Many clubs present the visiting Governor with a small gift as a token of respect and appreciation for the time and effort in fulfillment of his duties. A donation to one of the State projects in the Governor's name is a particularly meaningful gift.
