### **Leader Dogs for the Blind**

Founded by three Detroit area Lions Clubs members in 1939, Leader Dogs for the Blind provides dog guides for people who are blind and visually impaired to enhance their mobility, independence and quality of life. Each year, over 270 attend our 26 day residential training to be paired with a dog guide. This is a life-changing event that opens the doors to independence.

In addition to our dog guide program, we offer programs that enhance a person's independence and quality of life in other ways, including orientation and mobility training, Trekker training, and seminars for Orientation and Mobility professionals. Currently, Leader Dogs is the only facility in the Western Hemisphere to teach deaf-blind students to work with a dog guide,

Thanks to generous donations from our supporters, our dog guide services are provided free of charge, including room and board, and travel to and from our campus in Rochester Hills, Michigan, for students living in North America.

Leader Dogs is recognized as a "Best in America" Charity by the Independent Charities of America (ICA).

### **Eversight Michigan**

Eversight is a charitable, not-for-profit organization dedicated to the preservation and restoration of sight through transplantation, research, education and partnership. Eversight recovers, evaluates and provides human eye tissue for transplantation; supports research into causes and cures of blinding eye conditions; promotes donation awareness through public and professional education; and provides humanitarian aid to people around the world in need of sight restoring services.

### **Bear Lake Camp**

We aspire to provide a premiere outdoor recreational/educational facility providing opportunities for people of special needs to enhance self-worth, attain independence, acquire social skills and realize their full potential as human beings. We are dedicated to working with the greater community and include them as a partner in addressing the needs of society. We intend to provide an atmosphere that is wholesome, and encourages awareness and appreciation of our natural environment.

Summer sessions are available for children who are blind and visually impaired, deaf and hard of hearing and those with juvenile arthritis.

## **Lions of Michigan All-State-Band\***

Each year since 1948 high school band students have represented the Lions of Michigan in their annual parade during the Lions Clubs International Convention. Originally a high school band was selected to represent the state. In 1978 it was decided to let students from across Michigan participate and the All State Band was formed and it has performed at the convention ever since. The All State Band has become one of the Michigan Lions' most acclaimed youth activities.

All State Band provides its members with experience in four major areas: musical performance, travel & education, sociological growth, and "We Serve" – the Lions motto. Band members are Leo members who perform concerts at hospitals, orphanages, and retirement centers. They are Lions goodwill ambassadors.

## **PAWS With A Cause**

Paws With A Cause enhances the independence and quality of life for people with disabilities nationally through custom-trained assistance dogs. PAWS increases awareness of the rights and roles of assistance dog teams through education and advocacy.

We have placed more than 2,700 assistance dogs throughout the country in our 38-year history, and currently provide services in 29 states. More than 300 families are PAWS dog volunteers.

John S. Noel was a charter member of the Grand Rapids Lions Club in 1919, and he was Michigan's 1st President of Lions Clubs International in 1923-24. The award is duly named in honor of John S. Noel's accomplishments in advancing the cause of Lionism in Michigan and throughout the world and for his tireless efforts to help people in need

## **Helen Keller Fellowship**

Contributions of **\$750** for the Helen Keller Fellowship will be deposited in the Project Kidsight fund. The Funding will be used to identify and help children who have been affected academically and socially by an undiagnosed vision disorder.

## **Ken E. Lautzenheiser Fellowship**

Ken E. Lautzenheiser served Lions for over 45 years, and he was a charter member of the Inter-lakes Lions Club. Ken was elected to the Board of Lions Clubs International in 1985, and over his lifetime he served Lions in almost every capacity.

Ken E. Lautzenheiser was instrumental in organizing the Lions of Michigan Foundation in the early 1980's. He believed there was a definite need in Michigan for an organization that could address the medical needs of individuals that had no insurance and nowhere else to turn. Ken knew that if Lions Clubs combined resources, Lions could have a greater impact on their communities and do more to help people in need.

The Ken E. Lautzenheiser Fellow is available for contributions of **\$500** or more to the Lions of Michigan Foundation and is often used to recognize extraordinary efforts by a Lion or Lioness Club member - many Clubs and Districts use the award to recognize the Lion and/or Lioness of the year.

## **A. Charles Weir Sight Conservation Fellowship**

A longtime friend of the Michigan Eye-Bank, A. Charles Weir was a respected and beloved leader among the Eye-Bank's Board of Directors for decades. A retired educator, Weir spent 34 years as a teacher and administrator for vision-impaired children at the Michigan School for the Blind. He was also a coordinator for the Midwest Regional Center for Deaf-Blind Children, serving a five state region. An active member of the Bretton Woods Lions Club, Weir held many offices, including Club President, District Governor and Council Chair for District 11-C2. Additionally, he served as a Director of The International Association of Lions Clubs.

In recognition of humanitarian work, an A. Charles Weir Sight Conservation Fellowship is awarded to those who donate a combined total of \$500 or more over three consecutive fiscal years to the Michigan Eye-Bank or for people for whom a donation was made by others. Sight Conservation Fellows receive an attractive silver lapel pin, certificate, engraved crystal desktop pedestal, and a congratulatory letter.

Sight Conservation Fellows who make additional \$500 donations to the Michigan Eye-Bank, or in whose name \$500 donations are made, become part of the Sight Conservation Progressive program. Progressive Fellows are awarded a new lapel pin and congratulatory letter for each subsequent donation. (The first lapel pin is a one-stone silver pin. For each \$500 donation thereafter another stone is added to the pin.)

## **Louis Braille Award**

The Louis Braille is an award created in 2010 by PDG Wayne Kreitner and his son, Lion Michael Kreitner to honor a Lion who has, through their efforts, made outstanding contributions to our district with their hard work and dedication of service.

## **District Governor's Goals 2018-2019**

### **Leadership Development**

All Club and District officers will have access to the training necessary to do their jobs.

80% of district clubs will submit Monthly Membership Reports and Service Activity Reports.

### **Membership**

District wide we will induct 120 new members. We will decrease the number of Lions we lose for preventable reasons.

We will increase our female membership to at least 33%.

We will form one new club in our district.

### **Service**

The district will increase its reported service projects by 20%

### **LCIF**

In honor of their 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary, Lions Clubs International Foundation will be starting a 3-year \$500 million campaign. Our district will respond with at least a 10% increase in donations during the first year.

## **District Governor's Official Visit\***

The District Governor or a Vice Governor is required to make an official visit to each club during the year. With 43 clubs to visit, not counting special events, meetings and Conventions, the Governor's and Vice-Governors' schedules are quite busy. The following suggestions will help your club make the Governor's visit a pleasurable and productive one.

1. Plan early for Governor's visit. Contact the Governor to confirm as early in the year as possible.
2. Choose a date that is likely to have high attendance.
3. Your request for a visit should include all pertinent information such as date, time, location, and if a meal will be served.
4. No other speakers or programs, other than abbreviated business meetings, should be scheduled for this evening.
5. Assign a member to greet the Governor. If the club has particular concerns or issues it would like the Governor to address, inform the Governor before the meeting.
6. Prepare a suitable introduction for the governor. A past Lion dignitary might introduce the Governor.
7. All members should rise when the Governor is officially introduced and when the remarks have concluded. Let the Governor know in advance if you want him to induct new members, club officers or present special awards.
8. Many clubs present the visiting Governor with a small gift as a token of respect and appreciation for the time and effort in fulfillment of his duties. A donation to one of the State projects in the Governor's name is a particularly meaningful gift.
