PDG **Bill Simpson** commented that perhaps we should consider donating money to the State Projects. PCC **Janalee McClure s**tated Lions International Standard District Constitution states that the purpose of the District is to provide an 'administrative structure' to advance the Purposes of Lions Clubs International in the District. After much discussion: Consensus determined that if we have extra dollars we should increase the budget of the Governor, 1st Vice Governor and 2nd Vice Governor to help lower the 'out of pocket' expenses for the elected officials. That should also make it easier to get Lions to run for those positions. The recommendation was to increase next year's budget for Governor, 1st Vice Governor and 2nd Vice Governor. Lion Jackie Glazier moved approval to accept the Treasurers Report dated January 17, 2016. Motion seconded by 2nd Vice Governor Peggy Walls and Lion Sheila Ferrel. Motion Approved.

Zone Chairperson Reports:

- o 3rd Zone meeting will be held in Traverse City. Guest speakers 2nd VDG **Peggy** and PDG **Jim Walls**
- 2nd Zone meeting was held in Honor. Guest speakers were DG Pam, PDG Dan Gibbons and PDG John Monahan. We also remembered and honored past Zone Chair Lion Connie McMorris. The Zone voted to send the 50/50 to District for the Governors Banquet Cost Reduction Project.
- I have visited all clubs but one and that is scheduled when their meetings restart in the spring as half of the clubs in the zone are closed until spring.
- All clubs are active and working on summer projects and even trying new projects this year, such as pancake breakfasts.

- Kaleva Lions Club has lost 4 members so are not doing the pancake breakfasts right now. Still doing the weekly pastie sale, hosted the Oct. Zone Meeting with 4 of the 6 clubs attending, hosted the Zone Christmas Party and are starting to work on Kaleva Days.
- Will be visiting Manistee Lions Club Feb. 9th. Manistee has made donations to "Little Mary's Hospitality House" in Wellston, to Love, Inc. and donated \$250 to cover the cost of a free movie for children at the Theater in Manistee during spring break. They also held a Kidsight screening for 50 children at the Victorian Sleigh Bell Festival and gave each child a free book.
- Mesick Lions Club sponsored the 1st annual Halloween Carnival for the about 300 kids at the Mesick Elementary School. Mesick Club donated money for a healthcare trip to Haiti, sent students to Ferris Eye Center, held 2 Kidsight screenings, Mesick Elementary and Betsie Valley Preschool for 85 children, adopted a family of 6 for Christmas, have inducted 3 new members, worked a benefit night at Cadillac Cullver's and has started working on the 2016 Mesick Lions Mushroom Festival.
- Visited the Onekama Lions Club in November and viewed Lion Jackie's peace poster entries. Club is planning on their Valentine party for members and spouses and decided to start pancake breakfasts on the 1st Sunday of each month, May through September.

 - Midland worked with Kiwanis on a diaper drive, completed their white cane collections, hosted a banquet to honor cross country runners and assisted in the production of The Miracle Worker with a Leader Dog display and a Kidsight screening at the event.
 - Mt. Pleasant recognize 8th students of the month in 4 schools, helps teachers with classroom supplies and are now working with United Way. Their Chili supper is coming up and a project with the churches to help the homeless too.
 - Shepherd s is working on their Nut sale and Lucky 13 raffle, are helping the Chamber of Commerce for a Halloween celebration, is planning on adopting a family and is working with the fire department to help needy families with the holidays.
 - Vestaburg is planning their swiss steak fundraiser, they worked an auction with their food wagon, just did a KidSight screening of 95 students - gave each child a book and are planning on working with Santa at the Library.
 - Kaleva will be hosting a community Thanksgiving dinner for everyone for donations. They still do pasties every week for a fundraiser.

- Region 3, Zone 2 Lion Ray Williams
 - Second Zone meeting held Nov. 10th with four of the six clubs present. Next meeting 2-9-16.
 - Governor **Pam & Dan** covered District convention, tidbits, membership and leadership.
 - Lion **Bill Koch** spoke on the positive effects Kidsight has on children, families and even schools.
 - Presentation by Deb Davis from Paws with a Cause on the benefits a client receives when the dog is trained to assist them so they can live a more normal lifestyle.
 - Lion Ray suggested we use the talents in our District's colleges to get a PR program written up by the college kids for a school project. Could be a big help to stretch the grant money and give the kids some actual experience too.

Old Business

1st VDG Ron Gibson reported the paperwork has been completed, DG Pam is our resident agent, we've paid the \$20.00 so we are all set to have raffles. DG Pam encouraged clubs to attend the Michigan Forum & attend the session for raffles put on by the State of Michigan.

• The report on Criteria for the Howard Humanity Service Award is referred to the April Cabinet Meeting. DG **Pam** looks for this award being for the 'everyday' Lion that does outstanding Lion work.

State Project District Chairperson Reports

- All State Band Lion Christina Anderson absent. Governor Pam reported that All State Band would like to proceed with the requirements to become an official State Project. One of the first steps for this process is to get the endorsement from a majority of the Districts in the State. Lion Karla Roebuck moved District 11E1 approve endorsement for All State Band to become an official State Project. Motion seconded by 2nd Vice Governor Peggy Walls. After much discussion the motion was approved unanimously. Governor Pam directed Secretary Janalee to send a letter to that effect to PDG Dave Bennett.
- **Bear Lake Camp** Lion **Dennis Belford** reported Bear Lake had a wonderful summer serving 410 campers last year. District 11E1 attendance was up. The new promotion pamphlets are going out after the first of the year. Governor **Pam** reported she was the only Governor that attended Governor's Day at Bear Lake Camp this year.
- Leader Dog Lions Pam Blizzard & Ronald Sharp absent but offered programs to clubs & reported:
 - Phase one of construction is almost 100% complete and the new puppy area & veterinary clinic are very close to being fully functional.
 - Phase two includes the renovation of the training bays in the south wing, one bay is almost complete and new masonry walls are going up in the other two bays. A garage addition, new duct work, a new air exchange system, new electrical & new plumbing are also included in phase two.
 - Campaign is just under \$600,000 remaining of the \$14.5 million dollar goal.
 - 14 District 11E1 Clubs have committed \$9,760 for the Kennel project.
 - Year 2014-15 shows 35 Clubs donated \$10,466 to Leader Dogs operating funds.
 - Last year Leader Dog graduated 198 Leader Dog Teams (Client & Guide Dog), paired 11 Deaf/Blind Clients & gave White Cane training to 77 students.
 - Note: Governor **Pam** has researched a bus trip to Leader Dog with pick-ups in Traverse City, Mt.
 Pleasant, and Cadillac. Bus carries 56 people, for \$1,825.00, which comes to \$33.00 per person if bus is completely sold. Maybe late May or early June.
- Michigan Eversight PDG Lynn Mast absent, PDG Bill Simpson reported on Eversight and Michigan Pin Traders: Eversight has a new CEO, Diana Kern. Her background is management within charitable organizations. Michigan Pin Swap will be in Paw Paw in May with attendees from several states. I'm President and invite all you to attend and bring guests.

- International Convention 1st VDG Ron Gibson introduced us to his 'ambassador of good will' Lion, Winston. He sings: I'm a Lion, King of the Jungle & I'm your friend. 2016 Convention in Japan June 24-28. Ron will be leaving June 19th and will return June 29th. Lions International 100th Anniversary will be celebrated in Chicago 2017. Detroit bid on 2021 International Convention for Cobo Hall.

 - Voting to have members of Campus Clubs only pay 50% of the District dues
 - Voting to allow District 11E1 Trustees to the Lions of Michigan Foundation to serve 3 consecutive terms of office, which complies with the Foundation By-Laws.
 - Lions International requires all Districts to adopt & incorporate the Standard District Constitution starting July 1, 2016. We already comply. After the District Vote April 8th the District Constitution will be updated and put on website by July 1, 2016.
