## **DISTRICT 11E1 Annual Business Meeting Minutes**

Governor **Pam Schroeder** (Onekama) called the meeting to order at 2:10 PM. Lion **Jackie Glazier** (Empire) led the Pledge. PDG **Jerry Brandt** (Harrison) offered the opening prayer.

PDG **Jim Walls** (Stanwood) moved approval of the agenda with the addition of a pro & Con discussion on the Constitution Amendments and PDG **Tim Anderson**, Global Membership Chairperson, for a 1 minute presentation from the last International Board Meeting. Motion Seconded by 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice Governor **Peggy Walls** (Stanwood). Motion Approved.

Governor **Pam** introduced Past International Director **Cindy Gregg** and her husband PDG **Tom Gregg**. They were greeted with a standing ovation. PID **Cindy Gregg** thanked District 11E1 Lions for the warm welcome.

Governor **Pam** thanked everyone for attending the convention. She said she's really looking forward to the wagon float parade this afternoon.

PCC Janalee McClure (White Cloud), District 11E1 Secretary presented the report of the rules. PDG Jim Walls moved approval of the rules. Motion Seconded by IPDG Pete Conarty (Midland). Motion Approved.

Treasurer Lion **Kay Brandt** (Harrison) presented the Annual Treasurer report for District 11E1. PDG **Tim Anderson** (Cadillac) moved approval of the Treasurer's Report. Lion **Ray Williams** (White Cloud) Seconded the motion. Motion approved.

PDG **Tim Anderson,** Global Membership Chairperson, reported the International Board approved increasing the new member fee by \$10.00 to a total of \$35.00 each new member starting July 1, 2016. He encouraged all Clubs to report your new members no later than June for this fiscal Lion year.

PDG **Jerry Brandt** (Harrison) presented the District Convention report: He asked everyone to turn their lanyards in no later than the banquet so we can use them again next year.

Lion Gayle Morlock (Evart) presented the official Credentials Report:

- Number of Clubs in District 11E1: 43
- Total delegation allocated from the 43 Clubs: 117
- Number of Clubs registered at District Convention: 25
- Total number of PDG's certified: 14
- Total number of Club delegates certified: 51
- Total number of delegates (PDG's & Club delegates) from the 25 Clubs certified at this Convention: 65
- District Officers and ballot issues that require a Majority vote is 50% plus 1 = **34 votes**
- Constitution Amendments that require 2/3 vote to win = 44 votes

PDG **Jerry Brandt** moved approval of the official credentials report. Motion Seconded by Lion **Ray Williams**. Motion Approved.

PCC **Janalee McClure**, Constitution & Bylaw Chairperson presented today's ballot resolutions and opened the floor for Pro & Con on each ballot proposal.

- Proposed Amendment #1 is a yellow ballot adding *Paws With A Cause* as a potential District 11E1 Project. Needs a majority vote.

- Proposed Amendment #2 is a blue ballot and puts Campus Club District Dues at ½. Needs a 2/3 vote.

  - o Con none
- Proposed Amendment #3 is a green ballot that allows our Lions of Michigan Foundation Trustees to serve 3 consecutive terms of office to coincide with the Foundation Bylaws. Needs 2/3 vote.
  - Pro PDG Bill Simpson
  - o Con none
- Proposed Amendment #4 is a pink ballot to approve *All State Band* to become an official State Project. Needs a majority vote.
  - No Pro or Con comments
