The Six Lakes Club Is Still Dealing With A Taxation Issue Involving The Use Of Their Meeting Locale And The Church Is Hiring An Attorney To Resolve The Issue. A Membership Issue In A Club Involving A Male And Female Has Been Resolved. A Marijuana Issue Involving A Club And A Local Election Was Brought To Light And Taken Care Of. All Zones Are Holding Regular Meetings And Will Meet At Least 3 Times This Year. The Zones Are Getting Stronger Thanks To The Efforts Of The Zone Chairs. Our Average 5 Year Membership Loss In The District Is 150 Per Year. We Should All Do Our Best To Help Retain Our Members. We Have 50 New Members In The District So Far This Year. Frankfort Is Starting To Grow, And Traverse City Is Now Meeting At The Elks Club. For This Year's District Convention, PCC Janalee McClure Is Taking Over As Credentials Chair.

We Need To Know In Order To Offer Support And Condolences To The Family(S). She Is Presently Working On The New Roster Book And Has Numerous Positions To Fill. She Is Looking For 5 Zone Chairs For Next Year And Has Other Committee Chair Positions To Fill. Some May Have Co-Chairs So Please Help Her Fill Them. If You Have People From Your Club Or Zone Who Might Fill One Of These Positions, Please Let Her Know.

**2nd VDG Elect Ron Gibson** Offered His Thanks For The Support Of The Cabinet And Voting Members And For The Mentoring And Teaching That Has Been Passed On To Him.

**Treasurer's Report**- Lion Kay Brandt Was Absent So Report Was Presented By 1st VDG Pam Schroeder. (See Attachment) PCC Janalee McClure **Moved** To Accept The Report For Audit Purposes, Seconded By PDG Dan Gibbons. The Motion Was Approved.

Cabinet Secretary Gibson Read A Letter Received From Lion Betty Cramer Of The Honor Lions Club Regarding Lion Connie McMorris. "Our Loss Of Lion Connie Is Still Being Felt By All Of Us At The Club. Connie Did So Much For Our Club That We Are Finding It Difficult To Fill All Of Her Positions. Her Passing Was So Swift That Some Members Who Were Away For The Winter Months Were In Disbelief. However, We Are A Club Of Great Resilience Who Will Come Together To Get The Job Done For The Coming Summer Season To Make Connie Proud Of Us".

Howard City Lions, Builder Of The Float, And Luther Lions, Storage Provider For The Float Are Able To Schedule And Use The Float Once Every Year, Without Cost, In Perpetuity, Howard City Lions For The 3rd Saturday In September And The Luther Lions The Saturday Of Memorial Day Weekend. The Motion Carried.
- 2. \$30.00 Membership Incentive, DG Pete Conarty. The Governor Reviewed The Job Of The Cabinet Secretary Based On Robert's Rules Of Order, To Properly Record All Motions. The Governor Reviewed What Had Been Discussed At The July, 2012 Cabinet Meeting And The Wording Of The Motion. He Also Indicated In His Review That Neither The 2012-13 Or 2013-14 \$\$30.00 Rebate Motion Indicated A Time Frame In Which The Reports Had To Be Made. Only A Time Frame For The Membership Count.
