Governor's Opening Remarks:

- -The Centennial Service Challenge Award was presented to PCC Janalee McClure, representing the White Cloud Lions Club. Also receiving the award are the Mesick and Weidman Lions Clubs who had no one present to accept it.
- -Certified Guiding Lions: PDGs Harry and Laura Johnson of Baldwin Lions Club have renewed their certifications.
- -Extension award for helping to establish the Michigan Crossroads Lions Club was presented to 2nd VDG Ron Gibson of Fremont Lions Club.
- -The 2 Paws award for outstanding zone chairs for the first six months were awarded to PCC Janalee McClure, White Cloud; Lion Peggy Walls, Stanwood; and the late Connie McMorris, Honor.
 - -The Governor thanked his cabinet members for all their hard work this year.
- -The Governor indicated that the District has 71 new members so far this year(that was updated to 76 by IPDG Tim Anderson).
- -The District is still exploring a new club in Suttons Bay and will actively pursue this possibility when the weather is more favorable.

- -Newsletter articles and pictures are still needed. The Governor has agreed to be the newsletter editor again next year.
- -Retention is very, very important. Many of this year's drops have been due to non-payment of dues. Club treasurers must follow up on delinquent accounts and encourage payment.
- -Tidbits, a fundraising booklet to help offset the costs of the District Convention, was the brainchild of PCC Janalee McClure. It brought in over \$300.00 this year and will be used again next year. A drawing was held for the clubs that purchased an ad this year and the winner was the Harrison Lions Club. They were given a voucher good for one free night's hotel room at next year's convention.

Gwen Botting, Executive Director, Opportunities Unlimited for the Blind asked to speak to our cabinet to update us on the current state of affairs at OUB and to request our continued support. Highlights of her talk included:

They are beginning their 21st year serving blind children, ages 7 through high school.

The goal is to help the children become employable adults, although 70% are still unemployed.

Most of the children come from low income families and attend on scholarship.

The State of Michigan owns Camp Tuhsmeheta.

Support from District 11 E-1 has been crucial to their survival.

 - -USA/Canada registration and volunteer forms are available.

Secretary's Report, 2nd VDG Ron Gibson

Minutes of January 17, 2015 District 11 E-1 Cabinet Meeting were presented for review. **Motion** made by PDG Dan Gibbons, seconded by PCC Janalee McClure to accept as presented. Motion carried.

Convention Report, PDG Jerry Brandt:

2015 Convention:

To date, 117 from 11E-1 have registered. We guaranteed the hotel we would reserve

57 rooms and have reserved 85 to date.

PCC Janalee McClure, acting Credentials Chair, reports 26 of 45 clubs have submitted delegate forms. Of the 111 eligible delegates, 65 have been reported by clubs. Of the 22 eligible PDGs, 15 have been registered.

2016 Convention:

In addition to the two locations mentioned as possible sites at the January cabinet meeting, West Branch and Clare, two additional locations have been researched. They are the Comfort Inn, Mt. Pleasant, \$92.00 per night plus taxes, and The Park Place in Traverse City, \$69.95 per night plus taxes. **Motion made by Lion Diane Fleming**, seconded by PDG Dan Gibbons and IPDG Tim Anderson, to have next year's convention in Traverse City again. Discussion held, motion withdrawn, and new motion made and seconded by same people, to hold a 2 day convention at the Park Place Hotel in Traverse City on April 8 and 9, 2016. This will be a District 11E-1 convention only. Motion passed.

International Director Kembra Smith and her husband Lion Bill Lowe were introduced. She shared their excitement at being at our convention and looking forward to meeting many Michigan Lions.

MD11 Convention, PDG Laura Johnson:

This year's convention will be at Holland's DoubleTree Resort May 15-17. The theme will be The Roaring 20s and this year's keynote speaker is PID Brian Sheahan.

International Convention, PDG Harry Johnson:

This year's convention is in Hawaii and there are 110 from Michigan registered. The Michigan night will include a luau and there will be dancing and a history of the island.

Retention, PDG Lynn Mast:

There is concern over the number of drops this year and an analysis needs to be done as to why members are dropping. While there have been 21 deaths in the District so far this year, 28 additional drops are from members with less than two years in Lions. We must continue to focus on the positives in our clubs. We must also conduct good, honest exit interviews. Lion Bill Koch suggested that the CEP program is an important step in analyzing a club and the areas it can improve in. Lion Lynn shared that orientation and mentoring are key to a club's success. Lion Harry Johnson stated that billboard advertising about Lions is a possibility and it was pointed out that as of April 1st, as part of Lions Centennial Celebration, Districts could qualify for up to \$1500.00 to assist in membership.

Pin Recycle Program, PDG Jim Walls:

To date, \$55.00 has been turned into the District for pin recycling. Encourage your members to turn in unwanted pins for trading or recycling.

District Strategic Plan, DG Pete Conarty for Lion Bernie Baldwin:

The rough draft presented and passed out at the January cabinet meeting has brought no feedback from the cabinet. Motion made by PCC Janalee McClure, seconded by PDG Dan Gibbons, to adopt this strategic plan, adding it as an addendum to our Policy Manual and creating a tab on our website for its access. Motion carried.

District Raffle License, 2nd VDG Ron Gibson:

Presentation was made as to procedure needed to apply for license via State of Michigan. This is about an eight week process with various District documents that need to be included in the application process. There is no up-front cost to the District. IPDG Tim Anderson indicated that this raffle could also be run through a club that already has a license. **PDG Bill Simpson motioned**, seconded by Lion Diane Fleming, that the District get a license to help offset convention costs. Motion carried. Lion Gibson to pursue this. NOTE: this motion will come under review at its July cabinet meeting for its appropriateness.

Voice Recorder for District Secretary, 2nd VDG Ron Gibson:

Prices for digital recording equipment, including microphones, range from \$150.00-\$250.00. This equipment is effective for properly recording minutes of cabinet meetings and other meetings called by the District. **Motion by Lion Diane Fleming**, seconded by PDG Dan Gibbons, to have the District purchase such equipment. Motion carries.

New Business:

PDG Bill Simpson reminds everyone that new name for Michigan Eye Bank, effective March 20, is Eversight Michigan.

PID Gary Anderson encourages everyone to attend/volunteer for and at USA/Canada Forum in Grand Rapids.

Closing Remarks, DG Pete Conarty:

Some of the agenda discussion from the cabinet meetings might be appropriate to highlight in the newsletter. We still have 3 months left in this year and there is much that can still be accomplished. Thank you again for all your hard work!
